ORDER

This matter is before the court on defendant Robert L. Moultrie's motion [17] requesting a *Daubert* hearing on the admissibility of polygraph examinations and to introduce the results of two polygraph examinations. Moultrie's request for a *Daubert* hearing is hereby GRANTED. The parties are ordered to appear on May 1, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. before the United States District Court for the Northern District of Mississippi located in Oxford, MS.

The parties should be prepared to argue the merits and qualifications of the polygraph examiners as well as the merits of polygraphy as a science. In particular, the arguments should address the usual protocol and procedure for the administration of a polygraph examination and whether that protocol was followed in the instant matter.
