ORDER

Comes now the motion made on behalf of the United States of America, by and through the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Mississippi, for a reduction of sentence pursuant to Rule 35, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, based upon substantial assistance and necessary cooperation of the defendant in upcoming cases. The Court finds the motion and its addendum to be well-taken and it should be granted.

The government's motion for reduction of sentence is hereby GRANTED.

The originally imposed sentence of imprisonment is hereby REDUCED to 12 months and one day, with the remainder of any unserved term of imprisonment to be served on house arrest. Defendant is to be released from the custody of the Bureau of Prisons and report within 2 days of his release to the United States Probation Service, Northern District of Mississippi. Defendant is to bear all costs of his travel therewith. All other terms of the originally imposed sentence remains in effect.
