ORDER

Before the Court is [1253], State Farm's "Emergency Motion to Compel Depositions of Cori Rigsby and Kerri Rigsby. Almost three months ago the Court granted State Farm's motion to compel the Rigsbys to each submit to an additional hour of depositions. Although the Court is mindful that this motion was filed only two days ago, the Court recognizes the pressing need to complete these matters as this case is set for trial October 6, 2008. Considering the brief amount of time allowed for the depositions, the impending trial date, and the need to avoid any further delay, the Court finds it reasonable to require counsel for the Rigsbys to choose from the following a date to conclude these matters:

August 18-22, 2008
August 25-29, 2008
September 2-4, 2008

The Rigsbys' counsel shall advise Defendants' counsel of their choice by noon (central daylight savings time) Monday, August 18, 2008. Should counsel for the Rigsbys fail to choose a date, State Farm will be allowed to unilaterally set the depositions for a date from the above list.
