2. The parties have engaged in discovery on a formal and informal basis, though all discovery is not complete.

3. Plaintiffs have determined that all claims arising under the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act, 18 U.S.C. § 1961, et seq., (“RICO”) should be dismissed without prejudice as to all Defendants.

4. For purposes of clarity, except for all of their claims arising under RICO, Plaintiffs do not dismiss any of their other claims against Defendants.

5. All parties shall bear their own costs and attorneys fees with respect to the matters being dismissed herein.

6. All Defendants have been consulted and no Defendant objects to the relief requested herein.

7. WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request this Court to enter an Order forthwith (I) dismissing all claims arising under RICO without prejudice as to all Defendants.
