As requested, the following is a chronological detail of events that transpired during the week of April 5, 2004.

*April 5, 2004*

John Warren, Mike Lavengo, Steve Cannon and I met with Tim Whitmer, Jefferson Parish C.A.O. and Deano Bonano, contract monitor for Jefferson Parish at Timberlane Country Club to discuss the landfill expansion proposed by Waste Management with Jefferson Parish. We discussed the fact that Waste Management would be presenting a proposal to Jefferson Parish representing an extension of the existing contract.

*April 6, 2004*

I received a phone call from Tim Whitmer on my cell. At his request, I called Mr. Whitmer back from a land line. Mr. Whitmer informed me that Jefferson Parish President Aaron Broussard had meet with representatives of River Birch Landfill to discuss the Jefferson Parish landfill. Mr. Whitmer further advised that Mr. Broussard was not happy with the way Waste Management treated Bobby Bourgeois and River Birch was a good partner and known in the community. Mr. Whitmer further informed me that Mr. Broussard was inclined to retain the services of River Birch Landfill to operate the Jefferson Parish landfill. Mr. Witner further informed me that Mr. Broussard discussed with representatives of River Birch your role with Waste Management. Mr. Whitmer stated that Mr. Broussard wanted me to understand that River Birch was willing to retain my services in a similar capacity that I presently service with Waste Management.

*April 7, 2004*

I received a call from Dan Gerrity of CDM. CDM is the engineering company retained by Jefferson Parish to oversee the operation of Waste Management at the Jefferson Parish landfill. Mr. Gerrity informed me that Ron Austin, a private lawyer, wanted to see me to discuss landfill issues.

Mr. Austin is a close political ally of Councilman Byron Lee, whose district encompasses the Jefferson Parish landfill. I met with Mr. Gerrity and Mr. Austin at the Ye Olde College Inn Restaurant. The meeting lasted about 30 minutes. Mr. Gerrity excused himself after about ten minutes. At the time Mr. Gerrity was present the landfill other issues were discussed. After Mr. Gerrity left the meeting, Mr. Austin informed me that from this day forward I was not to contact Councilman Byron Lee or his administrative aid in connection with any Jefferson Parish landfill issues. That I was to address any landfill issues with him only.

*April 8, 2004*

I addressed John Warren of all of the above-mentioned events.
