- * With some krewes not parading in Jefferson Parish on Sunday due to the Superbowl we have saved funds from our normal Mardi Gras budget
- * The cost to put on a parade of this size can be in excess of 1 million dollars, with donations and in-kind contributions the actual total cost will be around 300,000

- \star When the Superbowl comes to New Orleans in the next few years this is a regional economic impact and visitors are not restricted to spending their money just in Orleans Parish
- \star Sales tax increases and the economic impact has spread throughout the region from Saints inspired purchases
