#### Cherreen,

I spoke with Tom about this issue and he feels that the decision on who is granted access should be made by Jose since it was an executive staff decision to deny access. If it is up to him, any attorney that can make a compelling argument as to why they need access would be granted access.

This morning Louis made a reasonable argument that the Parish benefitted from his access because he was able to address inconsistencies in information reported online prior to its print in the newspaper by contacting Drew Broach and providing the correct information.
