Enclosed is the Application for the Beer Permit.

Under 9, List 7-28, 7-29, 7-30.

Go to Item 12, you or whoever goes to Apply for the Permit will have to answer Items, 12, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, on 19 write in "N/A" , 20 and 21, 22 should be "YES" 23 thru 31 should ALL be "NO"(I have attached the 2008 application).

Whoever goes, send then with \$10 Cash, not sure if they take Checks?

Also required is a Letter from the IRS saying that we are a Tax-Exempt Status, I have attached that letter. Also Required is a Letter from the LA Secretary of State stating we are in Good Standing, I have enclosed that.

On the Application I did not list the address; you will see that on the 2008 Application I listed 4500 LA Hiway 1. I think I made that address up. One the Letter from the Town of Grand Isle (copy from 2008 enclosed) they list "Caminada Drive" that caused me a problem but I put on my "Sweet Eyes" and go thru it. The Letter from the Town needs to say 4500 LA Highway 1, Grand Isle, 70350(Check the Zip Code to be sure it is right). Tell Ray Sanity, the Town Clerk that the letter from the town MUST have that address on it.

Now we go to Jefferson Parish Cooperative Endeavour Agreement, I have enclosed the Resolution the Parish Council passed in June 2008, it was OK for 2008 and then when I went to get the License in 2009, this is when the Liquor People raised the stink and after much back and forth with Whitmere and Parish Lawyer and Liquor Board, Whitmere wrote a letter, copy attached that worked this out. So someone needs to get with Chris Roberts or John Young and get them to work with the Parish Legal people to write a New Resolution and include language from Tim's letter into this new Resolution. In the Resolution, you will see a "black ink pen mark" outside of Section One, I think the problem was the "automatic renewal", I think I would drop that out.

You can mail in the Application and just make a copy of your Driver's License and attach it to the application. I would call before sending in, the number is 225-925-4041 and letting them know it is on the way and ask them to call you when they receive it and call you if they have any questions. Just send a Cover Letter with it. These ladies are really nice to work with. They follow the Rules all the way.

If you drive, take I-10 to Essen Lane Exit, at the bottom of the Ramp, Turn Right and go down to the Second Red Light and turn Right, go down and you will see a building on your left with a parking lot in front. They are on the Second floor in the back of the building.
