

JUDGMENT

After considering the evidence and pleadings, the court being of the opinion that the evidence is in favor of William M. Magee and against the defendants, for the reasons assigned orally this date, and accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED the Motion to Dismiss, filed by the defendants, Daniel G. Abel, Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, Andrea Smith Lampo, Martin E. Regan, Jr., Kenneth A. Kulik, and Craig Henry Stewart, is hereby denied and defendants, Daniel G. Abel, Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, Andrea Smith

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Lampo, Martin E. Regan, Jr., Kenneth A. Kulik, and Craig Henry Stewart are cast with all costs of this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion to Disqualify Daniel G. Abel as counsel for the defendants, Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, Andrea Smith Lampo, Martin E. Regan, Jr., Kenneth A. Kulik, and Craig Henry Stewart, is granted with the defendants being cast with all costs associated with this proceeding. The defendants, Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, Andrea Smith Lampo, Martin E. Regan, Jr., Kenneth A. Kulik, and Craig Henry Stewart, are ordered to obtain substitute counsel and to notify plaintiffs of same within thirty days of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion to Compel Discovery and for Contempt against C & C Investigations, LLC is granted and C & C Investigations, LLC is ordered to appear at the office of William M. Magee, 207 East Gibson Street, Covington, LA on or before August 30, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. and respond to the subpoena duces tecum served upon it in this proceeding through its agent, Chris Yount, on February 22, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. C & C Investigations, LLC is further cast with all costs of this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion to Compel Attendance at Depositions and for Contempt against Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, and Andrea Smith Lampo, is granted and Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, and Andrea Smith Lampo, are hereby ordered to advise plaintiff, William M. Magee of new counsel within thirty days of this judgment for purposes of scheduling their depositions or if no new counsel is obtained in the time granted, to contact plaintiff, William M. Magee to re-schedule their depositions to be taken in this proceeding. These defendants are further ordered to pay all costs associated with this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion to Compel Attendance at Deposition and for Contempt against Kenneth Kulik is hereby granted and defendant, Kenneth Kulik is hereby ordered to advise plaintiff, William M. Magee, of new counsel within thirty days of this judgment for purposes of scheduling his deposition or if no new

counsel is obtained in the time granted, to contact plaintiff, William M. Magee, to re-schedule his deposition to be taken in this proceeding and to produce the documents requested in the Notice of Deposition filed in this proceeding. Defendant, Kenneth Kulik is further cast with all costs of this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion to Compel Discovery and for Contempt against defendants, Daniel G. Abel, Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, Andrea Smith Lampo, Martin E. Regan, Jr., Kenneth A. Kulik, and Craig Henry Stewart is granted and Daniel G. Abel, Lloyd Raymond Martin, III, Nicole Easterwood Martin, Carol Robinson, John George Lampo, Andrea Smith Lampo, Martin E. Regan, Jr., Kenneth A. Kulik, and Craig Henry Stewart are hereby ordered to respond to the Request for Admissions, Interrogatories, and Request for Production served upon them with the original petition in this proceeding within thirty days of this judgment and are further ordered to pay all costs associated with this proceeding.


The court has declined to award attorney's fees to plaintiff, William M. Magee, at this time and reserves the right to re-consider doing so in the event its orders in this judgment are not complied with.
