I veto the following:

- 1. <u>Motion to Open Account:</u> On page two of five, I <u>veto</u> the Council action to open an account for the Community Center. This particular authorization is confusing, misleading, and ambiguous. The request does not properly direct the City concerning these accounts, and it appears to me that the Council is requesting an escrow account for the Community Center and after a finalization of same, the funds are then transferred to the general fund.
- 2. Motion to Approve the Docket of Claims #16-005 (A.P., P.O. and Restitution and Bonds Payable): On page two of five, I veto this matter for several reasons. Most importantly, the failure to enclose what funds these bond and restitution payments are to be made from. Also, the Docket Number on the Exhibit is inaccurate.
- 3. Exhibit A does not have the accurate identifying Docket Number attached to the docket totals. Therefore, I <u>veto</u> same.

I veto the following:

- 1. <u>Motion to Close Street:</u> On page one of five, I <u>veto</u> the issue under Guests, (a). The Motion to Close Streets. This action does not specify what particular event the City is closing the streets for.
- 2. Motion to Approve the Docket of Claims #16-004 (A.P. and P.O.): Also on page one of five, I veto the City Clerk's report wherein the City Council is attempting to approve Docket of Claims #16-004. Stated in the body of the Motion, there are references to the Docket of Claims #16-002, although the documents submitted by the administration were for Docket of Claims #16-004. Also note that Exhibit A, which is the docket totals, references a Docket #16-064, which is also inaccurate, it should be Docket #16-004.
- 3. On page two of five, I <u>veto</u> the Minute reference which states that the Mayor was certifying the Docket of Claims of Claim #16-004. This should actually state that the Mayor is certifying that the funds are available and I was not certifying the Docket of Claims.
- 4. <u>Motion to Authorize and Direct Cleanup</u>: Also on page two of five, I <u>veto</u> this action on the grounds that this action is vague, confusing, and not proper.

5. <u>Motion to Authorize:</u> I also <u>veto</u>, on page three of five, the Motion to Authorize because the wrong Docket of Claims number was attached thereto.
